# ***The Journal of Rainfed Farming***

## **GUIDELINES TO AUTHORS**

*The Journal of Rainfed Farming* is a periodical for the publications of original research in all branches of agricultural sciences relating to the rainfed situations particularly harsh environments of arid and semi-arid regions. The *Journal of Rainfed Farming* is published twice each year (January and June)

1. Original research articles not exceeding 10-12 typed pages, including references, tables etc. should be submitted in duplicate to the Chief Editor, *Journal of Rainfed Farming*.
2. Short research notes, not more than 3-4 typed pages without any sub-heading giving all the information in a comprehensive manner, may also be published.
3. Critical review research articles are accepted on invitation only.
4. Title should be short, specific and informative. It should not be in phrased form.
5. A short title not exceeding 20-25 letters should also be provided for running headlines.
6. By-line should contain, in addition to the names, the place (organization) where research was conducted. The change of address should be given as a footnote and correspondence address separately along with digital address.
7. Abstract, written in complete sentences, should not have more than 150 words. It should contain a very brief account of the introduction, materials, methods, results, discussion and conclusion, so that the reader need not refer to the article except for detail study. It should not have references to illustrations and the tables.
8. Introduction part should be brief and limited to the statement of the problem or the aim and scope of the experiment. The review of recent literature should be pertinent to the problem. Key words of the article should be given in the beginning.

9. Relevant details should be given of the materials and methods including experimental design and the techniques used. In case the methods are well known, citation of the standard work is sufficient. The statistical methods used should be clearly indicated.
10. Results and discussion should be combined.
11. The results should be supported by limited number of tables/graphs or pictorial materials wherever necessary.
12. The tables should fit in the normal lay out of the page (kindly see recent issue of *the Indian Journal of Agriculture Science*). All weight and measurements must be in SI (metric) unit.
13. For citing references a recent issue of the journal or *Indian Journal of agriculture science* should be consulted.
14. Proof correction should be in ink, in the margin. All queries marked in the article should be answered. Proofs are supplied for a check-up of the correctness of type-setting and facts.
